New functionality or enhancements

[MCIX-155] – In upload processes and templates, switch using Place Codes (Pcodes) from MIMU instead of township name

Upload Files Module has been modified to accept the township information using Place Codes (Pcodes) from MIMU instead of township name in CSV template file. The use of Pcodes will reduce the error and streamline the process of completing the township information. This also addresses the situation with multiple townships with the same name.

Starting from April 2019, users must use Place Codes (Pcodes) in the township column for both “active client” and “write off client” files. The change is also made to be backward compatible with previous templates until June 15. For example, users who still submit the template with township name instead of Pcodes will still be able to upload data till June 15, 2019

- Place Codes for Township Format (MMR + Division Code + Township Code)
- e.g. MMR001001 (Pcodes is available from MIMU data CSV file)

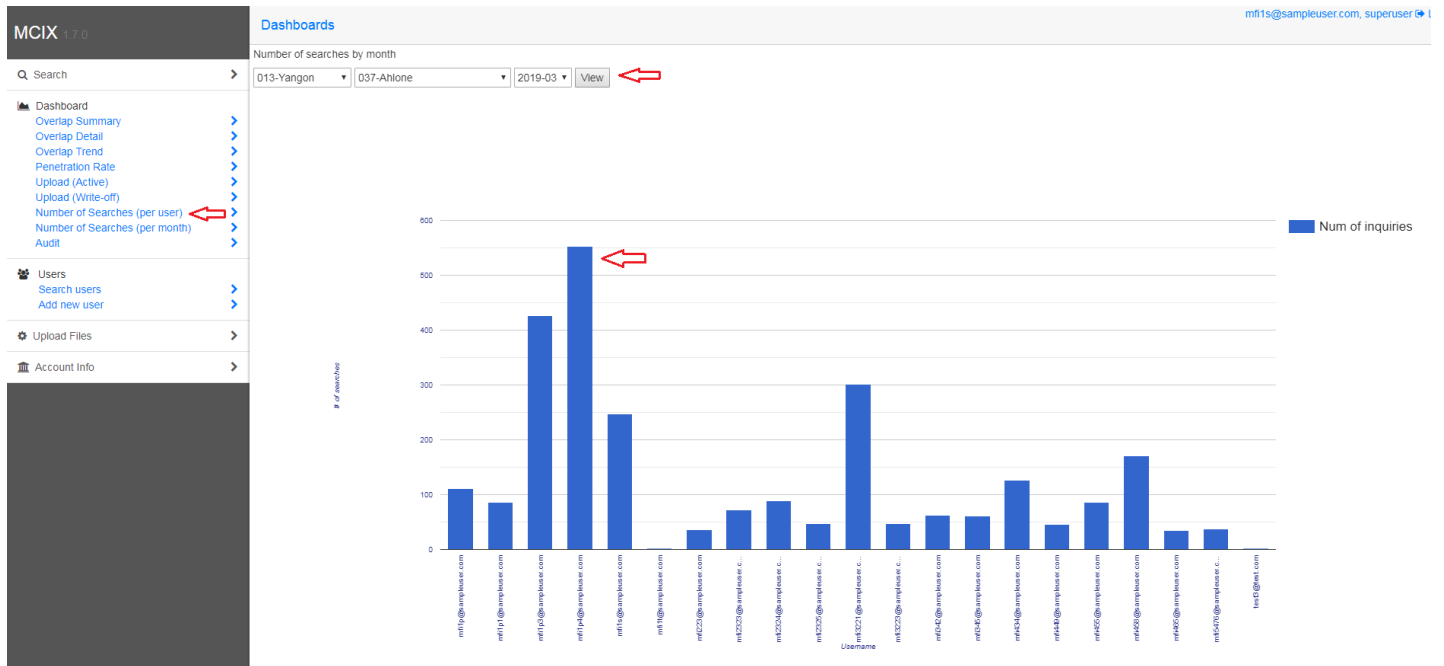
[MCIX-156] – Add Number of Searches (by user) chart

‘Number of Searches (per user)’ Module has been added to MCIX which enables super user and power user to view the number of searches per user by their divisions and townships for each month.

Note: If you wish to restrict power users to access only specific division and/or townships, please update user profile with specific locations.

To view Number of Searches (per user):

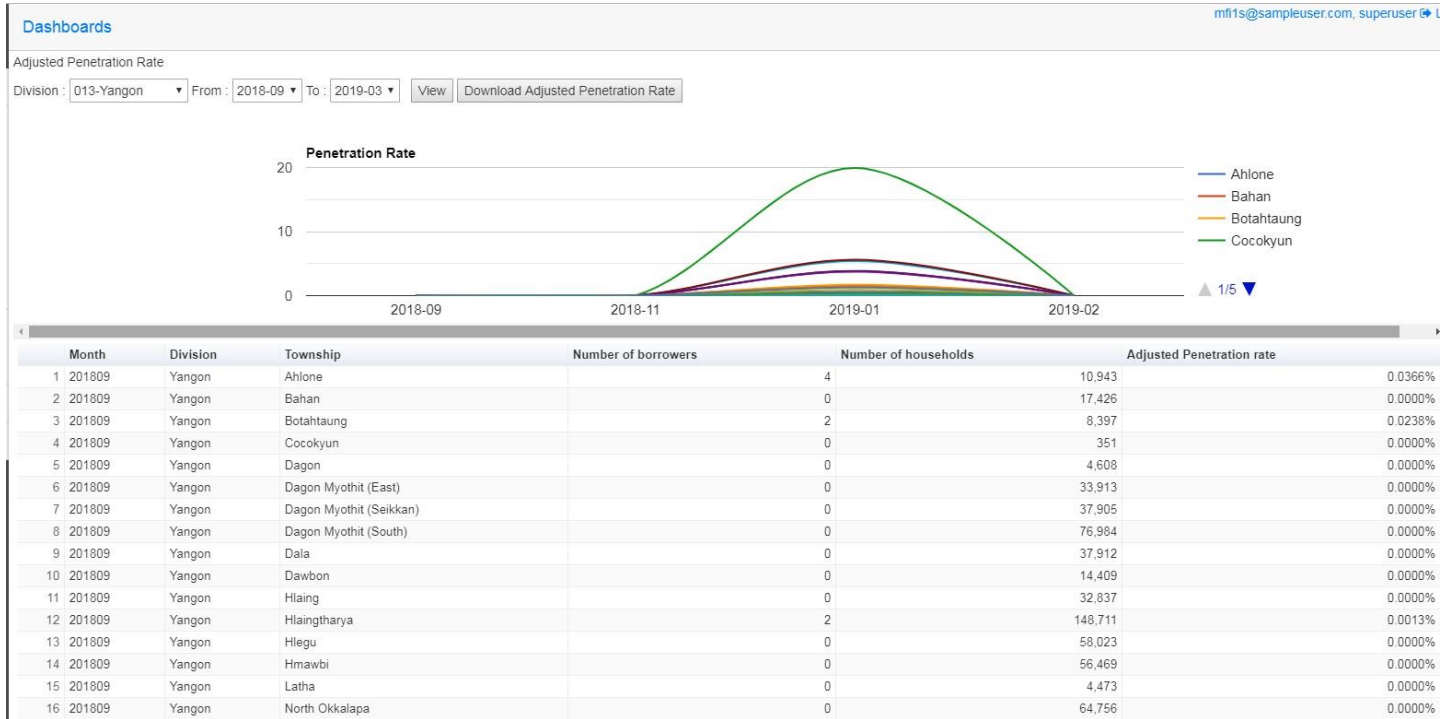
- Click on “Number of Searches (per user)” menu on the left navigation.
- Choose division, township and month.
- Click on “View”.
- Click on color line to view the search detail of each user (linked with Audit Report).





[MCIX-163] – View “Penetration Rate” in chart by division within given months

‘Penetration Rate’ Module has been updated to view both chart and table list of penetration rate by division within given months.



To view Penetration Rate:

- Click on “Penetration Rate” menu on the left navigation.
- Choose division, from month and to month.
- Click on “View”.

Note: Click on “Download Adjusted Penetration Rate” to down CSV file of Penetration Rate.



[MCIX-173] – Give access to “Power Users” to Audit Report

‘Audit Report’ module has been modified for Power Users to get access to view it.
